De hoc si simpliciterne Vultur sit, an ex Vulture & Aquila compositum genus, alij iudicent. Sed quid ego sentiam, iam dixi antea. An hoc sit genus illud, quod Albertus Homero Melanokōn vocari scribit? Huic enim soli peculiare est Leporibus insidiari, eosq; necare, præterea niger est, & pullos incorrupto alimento nutrit, docetq; venari, solus inter cæteras veloc, & ad docendum aptus.

VULTURIS aurei pellem ad nos, inquit Ornithologus, aliquando missam ex Rhædis Alpibus, rostro adhuc & cruribus hærentibus, dum contemplerer, hoc modo descripsi: Multa hic Vultur communia habet cum genere Aquilæ alpinæ (cuius figuram & descriptionem in Aquilæ historia primam dedimus) sed per omnia maior est. Longus est à rostro ad extremam caudam sex dodrantes & paulò amplius: ad extremos ungues quinq; dodrantes aut paulò minus. Longitudo superioris rostri, quantum eius aperitur, septem ferè digiti transversi. Caudæ longitudo circiter tres dodrantes. Tota pars supina, id est, collum inferius, pectus & venter, & pedes quoq; rufi sunt colore, dilutior quidem caudam versus, rubentior autem versus caput. Digni pedum fusco vel corneo colore sunt. Alarum penna longissima quatuor ferè dodrantes æquat. Subnigricant seu fuscae sunt omnes alarum pennæ vno ferè colore; parvulæ tamen supremæ in alis nigriores sunt, & per medium aliæ subruissis maculis, aliæ subalbidæ, circa imum distinguuntur. cō nigriores autem sunt, quò propiores dorso, vbi splendent præ nigredine. Pennæ per medium dorsum nigrae sunt, splendētq; in earum medio cauliculi albi, præsertim, quæ circa medium dorsum sunt, & dimidia colli parte: reliqua enim colli pars pennas ex albido rufas habet. Caudæ pennis idem color est, qui alarum, nempe fuscus. Huic omnino mihi respondere videtur, si tamen Vultures verè cognovit, genus illud, quod Albertus vocat Vulturem verum, Græcis, ut ille somniat, Gression dictum: maius cæteris sesquialtera proportionem, vocem edens fortem, colore citrino, aliquantum rubescente, rariùs apparet. Veruntamen si falsus voluit Albertus *ymior* dicere, quod Aquilæ aureæ competit: atq; is vel Aquilas cū Vulturibus confudit, vel non benè distinxit. Aurei verò Vulturis icon, quam Ornithologus exhibet, ea est, quæ capite de Leporatio Vulture secundo loco typographi incuriâ posita est.
