Ab huc enim etiam Ornithologo Helueto teste, aiunt capi, nō solum Perdices, Columbas, Cornices, Arcuatas, Anates, sed etiā Phasianos, & Tetraones. Vnde generosior aliqua prosapia ortum esse facile liquet. Nidificat, vt ait Stumpfius, in excelsis quibusdam petris, iuxta aquas, aut valles profundas, cū alibi, tū præcipue circa oppidum, quod tribunal Cæsaris vocant. Nidis exemptus mansuefit.
