Venerus indoctos Grammaticos apud Germanos esse scribit, qui Gruonspecthū suum, hoc est, Picum viridem cum Merope confundant, sed Aristotele, & Plinio reclamantibus. *a* Albertus ad eundem scopulum impingens Græca Aristotelis verba corrumpit, Auem esse somnians quæ Darharcaria Græcis dicatur, latine Meroli (Merops fortè dicere vult) seu Picus viridis, cuius vocem, & volatum augures obseruant; cū tamen apud Aristotelem solū Meropis nomen legatur, quem vt cū Pico confundit, sic Græca nomina nullius momenti sunt. Theodorus Gaza doctissimus Aristotelis interpres in translatione vocis Κολιος apud *b* Aristotelem imprudenter quidem, sed magno cum legentium detrimento Galgulum vertit, quæ sanè longè à Κολιος diuersa avis est, licet tamen *c* Plinius Galgulum Pici nomine, vt suo post loco dicitur, dignatus sit.
