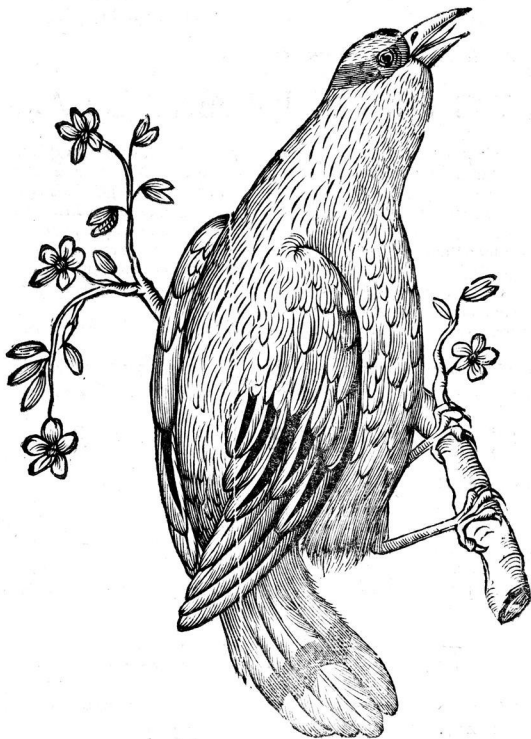

Vem hanc, cuius modo iconem exhibiturus sum, Illustrissimo ac Excellentissimo D. Cæsari Marchioni Facchinetto Senatori, & ciui Bononiensi, Innocentij noni, summi Pontificis, cui ea inter alias peregrinas suo etiam loco describendas ab Iaponensi Rege Sixto Quinto pariter Pontifici dono transmissas relicta erat nepoti acceptam refero. Hanc inquam exoticam auem Chloreū seu Chlorionē Indicū appellare placuit. Aristoteles enim, modo agnouisset, hanc potiùs, quàm postremum de scriptā *χλωριονα* absq. vlla hæsitacione erat nuncupaturus.
