Pauci devota meditatione luminaria considerant nisi deficientia, nemo cœtum istum astrorum, quo immensi corporis pulchritudo distingvitur, quamdiu nihil mutatum in ipso reperitur, spectat; sed simul ac quid præter consuetudinem emicuit, omnium oculi sunt in cœlo illudque tuentur. Hæc quod ita se habeant, nuperrimi comprobantur cometæ, quippe qui hominibus tantam incusserunt perturbationem, ut ignaros prorsus, utrum mirari debuerint, an timere plerosque reddiderint.
